That greater Wichita has over 7,000 negroes? That 65% own or are buying their own homes and property representing over \$995,850.00? That we have fifteen churches, with over 3100 members, 1 Y. M. C. A., 1 Y. W. C. A., 1 N. A. A. C. WICHITA—POPULATION 100,000

Wichita—The Air Capital of America. Wichita had a population increase of 149 per cent from 1900 to 1920, thus passing 66 cities and gaining the rank of 96th city in the United States. Wichita was incorporated 57 years ago.

Area of the city, 25 square miles.

Altitude, 1,183 feet.

Assessed valuation, \$119,422,155.

Banks, 16.

Post office receipts for 1926 were \$956,065.56.

Wichita has 17 parks, totaling 486 acres.

Of 165 cities from 30,000 to 100,000 population in the U. S., Wichita is among the eight enjoying the lowest rate of taxation.

Wichita has little smoke dirt because gas is used instead of coal for heating and factories.

Wichita has 5 country clubs.

Wichita has 6 municipal swimming pools.

Wichita had a school census of 25,175 in 1926.

Wichita has one of the few city owned universities in the United States. Wichita University has four colleges—Liberal Arts, Business Administration, Education and Fine Arts. The faculty is the leading faculty of the state in average educational qualifications.

In addition Wichita has Friends University.

Wichita's \$1,000,000 high school is one of the model high schools in the United States and is often visited by educators on plant inspection tours. W. H. S. has the largest tract of ground devoted to school purposes in the country. It has a seating capacity of 2,500, has modern woodworking and machine shops, the largest gymnasium in the city, a swimming pool, a laundry, an ice plant, a green house and a fine pipe organ.

Wichita has 35 public schools and 4 parochial schools.

Wichita has forty private and professional schools including two schools of aviation.

The American Indian Institute is located in Wichita.

Wichita has a Federal Land Bank.

KFH, Hotel Lassen, Wichita's radio station, is known all over America. Wichita is in the heart of the hard wheat belt and the Kansas oil fields. Natural gas and fuel oil is available at such rates that factories can use it for fuel.

Thousands of acres of land in the Arkansas valley near Wichita can be irrigated cheaper than land on the great government projects in the west. This is made possible by the great ocean of shallow water which underlies the whole valley. Land is near good markets which makes it more desirable than land in the big projects far from markets.

Six steam railways, one electrical railway, bus lines from all directions, national designated highways from all four directions and a national designated airway enters Wichita.

Wichita is fourth city in the U. S. in the milling of wheat, milling 11,000 bushels daily and having storage for nearly 10,000,000 bushels.
